Mr. Doug Biggers, address unknown, asked where to find the information regarding the Loyd Road variance question.


Councilman Blair Northen thanked everyone for coming to the meeting and letting their voices be heard.






Perry Lunsford, Post 1, Mayor Pro Tempore
