The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

The honorable mayor GW Davis Jr asked everyone to keep Lawson Moss' family in memory, stating that Mr. Moss passed away from COVID over the weekend. He then asked if anyone else had anyone they would like to remember over the Moment of Silence. It was requested to pray for Councilman Helen Robertson, who was absent because of her brother being ill. Mayor Davis also asked that everyone remember the first responders, doctors and nurses who are especially more stressed in their jobs even more so than a year ago because they cannot keep their offices staffed. 
